

Trustee Meeting October 6, 2015

Minutes from previous meeting approved by Ed, seconded by Derik and carried.

Finance Committee: Congregation to receive graph showing levels of giving upcoming. Max Schipper and Arnold Burke added to signature cards on CD for Burmeister and Farrar trusts.

Ad Board: Authorized Clark Homes and other similar organizations to explore feasibility of retirement housing project on church property North of church.

Old Business:

West Michigan Seal Coat crack filling is not quite finished. Greg to double check if complete and examine if tar is possibly chipping off.

Leak in women's restroom near classrooms is an ongoing concern. Will check after a heavy rain and during the winter.

Parsonage garage floor update: new concrete is in and curing. Pastor will be able to park vehicles in garage soon. Pastor reports there is now a 1 foot step up into house from garage floor. Will provide a concrete step to ease entry into house. Cost of floor is \$2,156.

Parsonage Chimney needs to be re-bricked, according to Stan. There are three options: Remove existing bricks and 1.rebrick from flashing, 2. Sheet and siding 3. Stucco. Will obtain estimates and work on next year. A new cap is also required.

New Business:

Snow-thrower for church approved purchase of a new snow blower and enclose. Max has been To Cox in Scottville, and cost of 24 inch compact (without enclose) is \$799. Dennis Genson, who does the majority of the snow removal prefers a 30 inch. Will price out this option. The church will be reimbursed by a private party.

Winterization of pavilion will be done. Plumber will show church member the process of closing off water. Men's urinal was found to be broken during recent scout sleep over. Plumber to Repair.

Coat rack in education wing was repaired by Max using Butterfly anchors.
