*From Max Schipper, Trustee Chairman:*

We were told that when we installed LED light fixtures in our sanctuary they would last more than 15 years; so in May 2015 we went ahead with removing the pews, renting a 50' lift, removing the old fixtures, and installing the new LED fixtures. We thought we were done with lighting problems in the sanctuary for 25-30,000 hours! Wrong again!

As you can see, about 1/3 of the fixtures have failed in just 15 months! The manufacturer has accepted responsibility for the defective fixtures and has shipped us replacement fixtures which have had the defect corrected (fingers crossed) and will last 25,000 hours!

BUT...we need our volunteers to repeat what we did 15 months ago. The plan is as follows:

After the second service on Sunday, November 6, we need men to (1) loosen the pews with allen wrenches, (2) lift the pews onto dollies, and (3) remove them to the Christian Education hallway. With enough help, this will take less than one hour.

On Monday, November 7, we will use a rented lift to remove the current fixtures and replace them with new ones. Once this is completed, we again need volunteers to return on Tuesday, November 8, at 5:00 pm to bring the pews back into the sanctuary, install them, and tighten them down. WHEW!

If you could help us after the 2nd service on Sunday, November 6; or at 5 pm on Tuesday, November 8, the trustees would be most grateful.
