Lent began on Ash Wednesday, March 1 and continues until Holy Saturday, which is the day before Easter Sunday (April 16). This year we have **Lenten booklets** entitled *At the Crossroads* available on the Literature Table in the hallway near the church entrance. Please take a copy for use by you and your family during the Lenten period.

Today is **UMCOR Sunday**, previously known as One Great Hour of Sharing. Your special offering enables United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) to reach out through worldwide ministries of food, shelter, health and peace. It pays for the administrative costs of UMCOR. Because of your UMCOR Sunday offering, when anyone gives to UMCOR, 100% of the gift goes to those in need. *Editor's Note: Charity Navigator, America's largest independent charity evaluator, gives UMCOR a 4-star rating, which is Charity Navigator's top rating.*

**A discretionary fund** was established by the Administrative Board to enhance and expand the pastor's ministry to people within our church family in times of crisis and need in the name and spirit of Jesus Christ. This fund, used anonymously, is administered by Pastor Dennis and it enables him to respond to emerging and emergency needs as they occur within our church family. Those wishing to contribute to this fund will find special receptacles in the front of the sanctuary on Communion Sundays. You may place your offering in one of the receptacles as you come to receive Holy Communion. If you write a check please make it payable to the United Methodist Church of Ludington and in the memo designate it for "*Pastor's Discretionary Fund.*"
