### **Holy Week** is approaching!

- **Palm Sunday** is April 9, and there will be an Easter Egg Hunt for the Sunday School children at 10:00 am that day.
  - Thursday, April 13 is **Maundy Thursday**. Our weekly catered meal will be at 6:00 pm that day instead of Wednesday the 12th; and there will be a Maundy Thursday worship service at 7:00 pm. The service will feature Communion and foot washing.
  - The next day, April 14, is **Good Friday**. There will be a Community Good Friday service from noon to 3:00 pm at Scottville United Methodist Church. Pastor Dennis will read the Scripture in the first segment (12:00-12:20), Our UMC Ludington Women's Ensemble will sing at the beginning of the second segment (12:25-12:50), and Rev. Ron Iris will perform a solo during the 1:15-2:00 segment. That evening, Pastor Dennis will lead a 7:00 worship service at our church.
- The last day of Lent is Holy Saturday. **Easter** is April 16. We will have worship services at 9:00 and 11:00, with Sunday School at 10. Becky Sopha has invited anyone who wishes to sing Handel's *Hallelujah Chorus* with the Chancel Choir at the 11:00 service. ### **Schedule change!**

Three weeks after Easter we will return to our old worship and Sunday School schedule, with one addition. Beginning May 7, Rev. Judy Downing will teach an 8:30 am adult Sunday School class. Contemporary worship and other Sunday School classes will be at 9:30. The traditional service remains at 11:00. Nursery will be provided from 9:15 to 12:15.
