From Judy Downing, Christian Education Director

- The junior and senior high "Sunday" school classes are held on Wednesday nights at 7:15 pm, so that the youth can remain active during the 9:30 am worship services on Sunday. They will be dealing with scripture and how it relates with their lives today. We will meet in the Christian Education wing in the 4th-5th grade room. (Due to the Legacy Sleepover, there will be no Youth Sunday School March 28. Judy will be gone April 4 and 11, so there will be no Youth Sunday School those two days either. It will start up again April 18).
- The scriptures covered for the 8:30 and 9:30 am Adult Sunday School classes from March through May will be Genesis, 2 Chronicles, Luke, John, Revelation, Exodus, Leviticus and the Psalms. We will learn about the Holiness Code, the Passover, and the role of memory and symbols; and we'll tackle who actually wrote some of the scriptures. Are you willing to learn some of that? We learn from one another as well as from the scriptures, and we all end up loving one another. Can you believe that?! We welcome you.
