Women's Fall Bible Study

Our Women's Fall Bible Study will begin on Thursday, September 6 at 10:00 am in Fellowship Hall. This fall we will study the *Matthew: People of the Kingdom, a Fisherman Bible Study* by Larry Sibley. Because of the length of this study we will cover 9 weeks this fall, and the remainder of the study will begin in the spring, March 7. Accompanying this study we will view the video of *Matthew*, in which Bruce Marchiano plays Jesus as a man of Joy. We will also be sharing Bruce Marchiano's book *In the Footsteps of Jesus: One Man's Journey Through the Life of Christ.*

From Judy Downing, Director of Christian Education:

- In September the Adult Sunday School will be covering the Book of Genesis; with God's Creation of the Heavens and the Earth (Plants, Animals, People, Family and Human Sin). In October we will be covering God Destroying and Re-Creating (Noah's faith, Abraham and Sarah, Isaac and Rebekah). Then in November we will be covering God Blessing and Creating regardless (Jacob receives Isaac's Blessing, Jacob forms a relationship with God, and God blesses Jacob and Rachel.
- What look like opposing realities such as Creator and Creation, Heaven and Earth, Chaos and Order, Water and Land, Male and Female, Work and Rest, among other things are really all a part of a whole. We will view these as not good or bad, but as a necessary part; not in opposition to God but a part of God's creative whole.
- We will look into the relationships of the people and will continue to see more couplets; such as Rebellion and Obedience, Conflict and Resolution, Honesty and Deception, Rejection and Acceptance, Weariness and Rest, Toughness and Tenderness.
- Through it all, we will meet a loving, creating and re-creating God who blesses, guides, makes covenant, restores, and redeems, in spite of our human sins. We see a God who forgives and extends divine hands of love and acceptance: a God who chooses again and again to work through flawed human beings to accomplish the divine plan.

Our Adult Sunday School classes begin at 8:15 and 9:30 am on Sunday mornings in the library. Everyone is welcome. Come, enjoy, have fun in the discussions and maybe even learn something new.
