Do you have a heart for sharing prayers and encouragement to others? Do you have a gift for those prayers and words of encouragement to be put into writing to be shared with women who are incarcerated? If so, SK Osborn wants to talk with you. The Kairos Prison Ministry is a national prison ministry program modeled after the Walk to Emmaus spiritual four-day journey. There is a Kairos weekend in March 2019 at the women's prison in the State of Washington that needs "agape letters" for the women in the program. It is simply sharing a scripture or words of Christian love, grace and encouragement to the ladies. It can be as little or as much as you are lead to share. **THERE ARE SPECIFIC GUIDELINES** that must be met regarding what can and cannot be said and done, how to address the ladies, the type of cards that can be used, etc. If you or a small group would like to take this on- SK has all the information. 34 cards are required and each one can be exactly the same.
